Plans Underway at Hoover Ridge

It's no secret that Hoover Ridge Park has undergone some major improvements and upgrades in the last decade, and even more in the last few years. Our next big project is set to occur in phases to alleviate the financial burden of the half a million dollar project.

Phase 1 and 2 of the project would include construction of a new accessible playground and splash pad, family bathrooms, and adequate parking. This area will be located near the new picnic shelter beside the sand volleyball court.

Phase 3 of the project would include three multi-purpose courts set for basketball, tennis, and pickleball. This area will be located below the youth football field, adjacent to the proposed playground and splash pad.

Funding for the projects will come from a variety of sources. Madison Parks and Recreation will continue to fundraise

through events, like Music in the Park and Haunted Woods. All proceeds from those events go directly to the Play-



ground Project.

Donations, grants, and other fundraising opportunities will also be necessary to reach the \$500,000 goal. The project, in its entirety, may take up to ten years to complete and is dependent entirely on funding.
